

Camp Rules

1. You are expected to stay at camp during the whole week unless the deans are notified and you are checked out by a parent.
2. The use or possession of tobacco (smoking or chewing), alcohol or drugs is strictly prohibited.
3. Each camper is required to follow the daily schedule except when permission has been given to the deans by the camp nurse.
4. Sickness and injury (no matter how small) must be reported to the camp nurse immediately.
5. The recreation director has complete charge of all recreation.
6. All High Schoolers who drive their own cars must follow these rules: a) Your car must be parked in a designated area. b) You must turn your keys in to the dean. c) Your car must be locked and you will not be allowed to get into it during the week.
7. In matters of dress, modesty must prevail. The deans will have final authority in matters of dress. Shorts and dresses must cover half of the thigh. NO bikinis, unless wearing a dark colored T-shirt. No attire may be worn which has printed material or pictures that detract from the spiritual atmosphere of the camp.
8. The deans, in consultation with other adult workers, have authority – given by the camp board – to dismiss any camper who violates these rules or who conducts himself in a non Christ-like manner.
9. Use of cell phones by staff only. They will be limited to emergencies. It is under the dean's discretion for personal use.

Please DO NOT bring these items to camp:

Knives
Guns
Weapons
Fireworks
Electronic games
CD Player
mp3 Player
Magazines
Bad Attitude
Phones

Snacks are not necessary...these are provided by the camp.
